Pure Master Privacy Policy

1. Information Collection:

Retention: We retain the data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy.

4. Data Sharing:

Third Party Services: We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer your Personal Data to outside parties except as necessary to operate our App, with trusted third parties who assist us in operating our App, conducting our business, or serving our users, provided that those parties agree to keep this information confidential.

Legal Compliance: We may disclose your information where required to comply with applicable laws and regulations.

5. Children's Privacy:

Our App does not address anyone under the age of 13 ("Children/Child"). We do not knowingly collect

personally identifiable information from children. If we become aware that we have collected Personal Data from children, we take steps to remove that information from our servers.
